### Ethical Considerations with This Response

- Are you a trained therapist or counselor?
- Were you in a position of power over this young woman?
- Should you have been validating her vs. questioning her?
- It might qualify as "gaslighting" to second guess why something should matter to someone. Especially when the concerns are legitimate. Which they are.
- Do you retell this story in an unethical way? Does her appearance of being shaken by your retort necessarily mean that her problems were resolved in the long term by your retort? I would love to talk to this sister missionary now to see if you, in fact, resolved her concerns. Do you know how we can get ahold of her?
- As a professional apologist, do you not understand why questions about Joseph Smith and Mormon church history matter to people who are doubting?
- What are the implications of sharing this story more broadly?


Joseph Smith secretly married so many women that we don't know the exact number.



types of sealings. The exact number of women to whom he was sealed in his lifetime is unknown because the evidence is fragmentary. <sup>24</sup> Some of the women who were sealed to loseph Smith later testified that their marriages were for time

Joseph Smith married at LEAST 34 women, including domestic help, sister pairs, mother/daughter pairs, at least one 14 year old, and several already married women.





Joseph Smith married at least one 14 year old.



The youngest was Helen Mar

Kimball, daughter of Joseph's close friends Heber C. and Vilate Murray Kimball, who was sealed to Joseph several months before her 15th birthday. Joseph Smith lied to Emma about most of his 30+ wives





### Plural Marriage in Kirtland and Nauvoo

<sup>39</sup> But Emma likely did not know

about all of Joseph's sealings. 40

- Marrying 34+ women, domestic help, one 14 year old, sister pairs, mother/daughter pairs, and already married women.
- Lying to his wife and "followers".

The overwhelming majority of Mormon church members and converts were NEVER TOLD about Joseph Smith's sexual behavior. This remains true to this day.






